ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER 21-003

The Tenth Judicial District Court being located within a Nevada County having been deemed by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) as having substantial or high transmission of COVID-19; and based upon the highly infectious nature of COVID-19; and in order to protect the citizens of Churchill County, Court Staff, and Law Enforcement personnel; and recognizing that the Sheriff is duty bound pursuant to NRS 248.100(3) to execute on all warrants of the District Court;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Sheriff or a Captain of the Sheriff's Department, at their sole discretion, is authorized upon contact with an individual who is positive for COVID-19 or believed to be positive for COVID-19, for whom there is an outstanding arrest warrant from this Court, to release that person and direct Sheriff Department personnel to provide that person a court date on the first Tuesday at least twenty-one (21) days after release for a hearing at 9:30 a.m. before the District Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Sheriff or a Captain of the Sheriff's Department also direct Sheriff Department personnel to further inform the person to check in by phone with Court Services within 24 hours of their release and comply with all directions given by Court Services including a daily phone call check in until further Order of the Court.


1 IT IS FUTHER ORDERED that Court Services design and provide to the Sheriff's Department a
2 one (1) page form that will be signed by the individual being released containing all of the required
3 information. A copy of this form will be e-mailed by the Sheriff's Department to the District Court and
4 Court Services within 24 hours or less of the individual's release time.

5 This Order applies to all District Court warrants, excepting and excluding, any warrant for a
6 Category A or B Felony charge.

7 This order will remain in effect until further notice.
